Athletic Scholarship Program

Description of Award:

The Chapin Eagle Club Athletic Booster Club will award a minimum of four \$1,000 scholarships to graduating Seniors who plan on attending a college, university or technical school upon graduation from Chapin or Spring Hill High School. The scholarships will be awarded to two female and two male students.

Application and Award Process:

- Applications will be available in the Guidance Office and the Eagle Club Website, www.chapineagleclub.org.
- A completed application must be submitted to the Guidance office by Friday May 1st, 2020.
- No late applications will be accepted.
- All applications will be kept confidential and processed by the scholarship Selection Committee.
- Recipients will be announced at the Senior Awards ceremony in May.
- Award checks will be made payable to the student upon verification of registration to an accredited college, university or technical institution.

Requirements:

1. Be a graduating CHS or SHHS senior who must be accepted by a post-secondary institution. Post-secondary institution includes, but are not limited to, colleges, universities, technical and vocational schools.
2. Must have lettered twice for Chapin High School by the end of the Spring semester of her/his senior year.

3. The student athlete must have a minimum cumulative un-weighted high school grade point average (GPA) of 2.0 on a 4.0 grade scale. An official school transcript must be submitted with application
4. The student and or student's parent/guardian must be an active member of the Chapin Eagle Club. An Active member is defined as a paid member by no later than December 31st of the student's senior year.
5. Applications must have one recommendation from a coach, teacher or administrator. Those completing the letter of recommendation must place the letter in a sealed envelope and sign the envelope prior to giving the letter to the applicant.
6. All applicants will write an essay on what their participation in high school sports has done for them. The essay must be typed on a separate sheet of paper and attached to the scholarship application form. The essay must be between 100-200 words. The essay will be judged on content, grammar and organizational style.
7. Students must complete and submit, by the posted deadline, the application with all prescribed forms, the official school transcript and least one sealed recommendation letter.
8. Selections Criteria- Scholarships are given based on merit. Financial need is not a factor or consideration in applying for the scholarship. The application will be evaluated on the basis of their athletic success, dedication, sportsmanship, leadership, academic achievements, community service and character. A point system along with an essay review will be used to determine which candidates are most qualified to receive the scholarship.

The completed application form, official transcript and the sealed recommendation must be submitted to either a Chapin High School or Spring Hill High School Counselor by May 1st, 2020. No late applications will be accepted.
